

## If worker unwell or confirmed case of COVID-19 at work

**UNWELL** means **any** of – fever / runny nose / sore throat / shortness of breath



### 1. BARRICADE

Barricade the relevant vehicle e.g. tractor that the worker has been using. Unwell worker to place the vehicle outdoors if possible, open all windows and doors and ventilate for at least 30 minutes before cleaning



### 2. ISOLATE

Isolate person from others and provide a disposable surgical mask if available



### 3. INFORM

Ring your local Doctor / GP or the national COVID-19 Hotline 1800 020 080 for advice



### 4. TRANSPORT

Ensure person has transport to get home. Do not go to a medical facility without prior phone contact



### 5. CLEAN

Clean all hard surfaces with a detergent spray (e.g. Ajax, Spray & Wipe) focus on high contact areas- steering wheel, gears, handles etc...  
Spray Glen 20 to soft surfaces/fabric if available e.g. seat. Ideally wear disposable gloves and dispose of gloves and cleaning cloth. Then **WASH HANDS**.

The vehicle is now safe to use



### 6. IDENTIFY

Identify if other workers had contact in an enclosed space for more than 2 hours with the person in the last 24 hours.

This will assist Public Health unit contact tracing and testing if this is needed later

## Unwell or confirmed case of COVID-19 at home



### 1. STAY HOME

Home isolate and do not go to work



### 2. INFORM

Ring your local Doctor / GP or the national COVID-19 Hotline 1800020080 for advice



### 3. IDENTIFY

Identify who had close contact for more than 2 hours with person in last 24 hours.

This will assist Public Health unit contact tracing and testing if this is needed later



### 4. CLEAN

Regular cleaning of surfaces in the home and practice all standard personal hygiene measures
